Plagiarism, fabrication, unethical or redundant publication violates the editorial policy of Journal of Education and Health Promotion, which follows best practice guidelines given by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) and Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) mentioned on the Information for Authors and as codified in the signed statements made by the authors regarding the copyright of their work.
